**Appointment**

- Each year, the CIOMR appoint a CIOMR liaison officers to CIOR Commissions
- This nomination goes from 1<sup>st</sup> of September to the 31<sup>st</sup> of August of the next year. ( term of 2 years )
- The candidature can be appointed for consecutive terms.
- During the MWM of the CIOMR EC meeting, the President will announce that there will be a call for nominations for that position. The Secretary General will send out the call for nominations via @mail in March.
- This call for nominations will be sent to each VP and the answer must be sent back before the 1<sup>st</sup> of May.
- If there are many candidates, we will organize an electronic ballot during June.
- If there is only one candidate, he/she must also be approved by the majority of Nat VP's.
- During the Summer Congress EC meeting, the CIOMR liaison officers to CIOR Commissions will be introduced.
- In August, the Secretary General of the CIOMR will formally inform the president of the CIOR commissions

**Tasks o of the CIOMR liaison officers to CIOR Commissions**

- Must regularly participate in the working group of the committee.
- He report on the activities of the committee at the MWM and the Summer Congress.
- The report must be sent to the International VP and the Secretary General of the CIOMR.
- The CIOMR cannot be responsible for any travel or other expenses.
