

By-laws First Aid Committee (FAC); as of 2008 Operational Medicine Committee (OMC)

1. Each country may have one official representative on FAC. Their voting privileges shall be as for CIOMR.
2. The Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary may be their country's representative and in that case shall have a vote, otherwise they shall not vote except in the case of a tie, when the Chair may vote (regardless of if the Chair voted already as an/the official country representative).
3. There shall be a Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary, each of whom shall be elected to serve a three (3) year term. The dates of these terms shall be staggered. Any vacancy shall be filled by election (may be done by electronic vote) to fill the unexpired portion of that term of office.
4. The FAC Chair shall be the Chief Judge
5. The FAC Chair and Vice Chair shall be the liaisons to the CIOR MILCOMPCOM
6. The FAC Chair and Vice Chair shall be the liaisons to the LOAC POC and the Host Committee competition organizers
7. The FAC Secretary shall take minutes at the FAC meetings and circulate them electronically to the FAC Chair and Vice Chair for input and then send to the CIOMR EXCOM and the FAC members.
8. There shall be a Chief Scorer and Deputy Chief Scorer. These officers shall be appointed by the FAC Chair, and ratified by the FAC, for a term of 2 years (Even years for Chief, odd years for Deputy). The FAC Chair shall appoint additional scorers, in consultation with the Chief Scorer, to assist during the Summer Congress.
9. The FAC shall review First Aid Handbooks and recommend a handbook as the official CIOMR reference. This recommendation shall be voted upon by the CIOMR voting body.
10. Planning, orientation and selection of judges shall be the responsibility of the FAC Chair. (See Appendix)
11. The FAC shall review the First Aid Competition SOP on a regular basis.
12. The FAC chair shall appoint a member to analyze and report on the scores as a guide to improvement for the competitors. This

individual shall take all the score sheets and have the analysis available for the following Winter Meeting. The actual score sheets shall be kept for the 2 immediate past competitions.

13. The FAC chair is responsible for preparing, in conjunction with the Host Committee, the scenario for the Summer Congress competition. (See appendix)
14. The FAC secretary shall be responsible for sending electronically the Bylaws and appendices relating to FAC to all new country delegates.
15. Electronic voting is authorized provided the official FAC representatives having e-mail addresses and responding, do so in a fashion that gives a simple majority of all eligible voters to one side of the question. If this does not occur, either the matter waits until the next meeting or the FAC Chair may attempt a hard copy mailing to those without email addresses. a simple majority of those eligible to vote
